

Future Focus Program Application 2022-2023

Program Description

The Future Focus Program at ph Apartments provides residents with an opportunity to bring their core values into dialogue with their future planning. Participants will have an opportunity to explore their personality, values, strengths and gifts as well as how to best use them in the world. The group will meet for 4-6 sessions **one weeknight evening (historically Mondays)** in the fall and 4-6 sessions **(same weeknight evening)** in the winter/spring; each participant is required to attend all group meetings. Participants will complete tools for self-reflection and talk with peers in small group about program topics. Future Focus program participants will spend time talking about how their gifts, background, values and personality can affect them in the workplace or in pursuing future goals. They may hear from guest speakers discuss how they draw on their values in their professional lives. Participants will also be challenged to consider what value they put on paid work compared to work they "donate" or volunteer to do in their community. We will also discuss personal finances and how the choices we make about earning and spending money can reveal what we value. Finally, participants will be asked to consider how to craft a life worth living, that includes but is not limited to their career/work. Participants are eligible for a rent scholarship available through Pres House Apartments.
